Children's Burn Foundation meets the needs of children and their families whose lives are dramatically altered by the tragedy of a childhood burn. Full recovery support includes life-transforming surgeries, specialized care, physical therapy, housing and transportation assistance, counseling, and opportunities for socialization with other survivors and their families. CBF reach is local, national, and international.

CAMP GUNG HO

Camp Gung Ho days are free, fun-filled adventures for young burn survivors and their siblings. Camp allows them to forget any stress, have fun, and just be kids. Camp Gung Ho activities have included fishing, swimming, art projects, surfing, and a day at Universal Studios.

FAMILY/CHILD SUPPORT GROUPS

Child burn survivors, their siblings, and parents face unique challenges. Certified child life specialists and social workers guide these families in support groups designed specifically for them.

TEEN SUPPORT GROUPS

Teen burn survivors find camaraderie in our program known by the acronym YABSS: Young Adult Burn Survivors & Supporters. YABSS support each teen's transition into adulthood, encouraging them to reach their full potential and embrace a bright and unlimited future.



PREVENTION & EDUCATION

Children's Burn Foundation educates children, parents, expectant parents, and other caregivers how to stop burns before they happen and how to reduce the seriousness of injuries that do occur.

CAREFUL, THAT'S HOT!

Parents and caregivers of young children are taught how to safeguard against burn injuries and what to do should an accident occur. The program targets at-risk populations and is available in English and Spanish at daycare centers, nursery schools, head start programs, and parenting classes in low-income communities.

THE L.A. TROUPE SAFETY SMART

More than one million Los Angeles County students, kindergarten through third grade, have reaped the benefits of The L.A. Troupe Safety Smart theatrical production. This renowned, interactive performance group entertains children while teaching burn prevention and life-saving skills.

SAFETY SMART BABIES

This program for expecting and new parents raises awareness of scald and contact burn dangers for young children and teaches prevention skills. CBF continues to develop partnerships with maternity departments at hospitals and health care programs.
